



## Current High School Seniors:

UT Promise is an undergraduate scholarship program guaranteeing **free tuition and mandatory fees for qualifying Tennessee residents attending UT's campuses in Knoxville, Chattanooga, Pulaski, Martin and Memphis.**

This innovative scholarship will cover a student's last-dollar amount of **tuition and mandatory fees** after other financial aid is applied (such as Pell grants, HOPE Scholarship or other institutional scholarships) to **students who qualify for HOPE and family adjusted gross income and untaxed income of less than \$60,000, AND a total maximum asset amount of less than \$75,000, as defined on the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA).** UT Promise is a student-success oriented scholarship program that **requires students to complete volunteer service hours and meet with a volunteer mentor each semester to ensure a successful student experience.**

| <b>Feb. 1, 2023</b>     | File the 2022-2023 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA). Visit <a href="http://www.fafsa.gov">www.fafsa.gov</a> .   |
| <b>March/April 2023</b> | Attend mandatory meeting with your Ayers Counselor.   |
| <b>July 1, 2023</b>     | Complete and submit 8 hours of community service. Submit by 11:59 PM CT at <a href="http://CommunityServiceForm(tfaforms.com)">Community Service Form (tfaforms.com)</a>  |
| <b>July 1, 2023</b>     | Ensure UT institution of choice is listed on your TSAC Portal and FAFSA.  |
| <b>July 1, 2023</b>     | Complete financial aid verification, if selected. Verification is completed through your financial aid office.  |
| <b>Sept. 1, 2023</b>    | Your financial aid verification must be fully complete (not just submitted for review) and your UT Promise award accepted by this date for you to be eligible. Failure to do this will result in not receiving the UT Promise. Do not wait to do this as submitting your initial documents may lead to the financial aid office requesting other documents. If your financial aid file is not fully complete, you will not be eligible. |
| <b>Fall 2023</b>        | Enroll as a full-time student at your UT institution of choice.   |

| <b>Dec. 1, 2022</b> | <b>Priority deadline to ensure UT institution of choice is listed on your <a href="#">TSAC Portal</a> and FAFSA.</b>   |
| <b>Dec. 1, 2022</b> | <b>Complete and submit 8 hours of community service.</b><br>Submit by 11:59 PM through your campus service tracking site. You may begin working on your service hours after July 1, 2021. You will submit your service hours through your campus service tracker with your NetID.
